The new AVP will be a strategically minded communicator who can partner with the Provost as the Chief Budget Officer for the Division of Academic Affairs at a vibrant, rapidly growing university.

Founded in 2002 and located midway between Santa Barbara and Los Angeles and 10 minutes from the Pacific Ocean, CSUCI is the newest campus of the California State University, the largest system of public higher education in the United States. The campus currently serves over 7,000 students. At its full capacity the campus will serve more than 15,000 students ([www.csuci.edu](http://www.csuci.edu)). CSUCI offers 25 undergraduate majors, ten graduate degrees, a joint doctorate in educational leadership, and a variety of certificate and teaching credential programs.

CSUCI is a Hispanic-Serving Institution that values the diversity of its students and community. The current student body is 48% Hispanic, 44% Pell Recipient, and 59% first-generation college students. Over half of CSUCI's undergraduates are transfers from community colleges. CSUCI is deeply committed to serving and developing all of its students.
