The President is also charged with all strategic and operational decisions within the day-to-day workings of the Institute. S/he will make final decisions on hiring, policy changes, and developmental directions. The President will report directly to the Board of Trustees.

This is a fast-track search with an appointment of the President scheduled for mid-June 2017. The new President is expected to take office early July 2017.
